Scripture Cake

Ingredients

1 cup Judges 5:25 (butter)
 1 cup Jeremiah 6:20 (sugar)
 1 tbs 1 Samuel 30:12 (honey)
 3 Jeremiah 17:11 (eggs)
 1 cup 1 Samuel 30:12 (raisins)
 1 cup Nahum 3:12 (chopped figs)
 ¼ cup Numbers 17:8 (chopped almonds)
 2 cups 1 Kings 4:22 (flour)
 II Chronicles 9:9 (spices such as cinnamon, allspice, nutmeg) Dash
 Pinch of Leviticus 2:13 (salt)
 1 tsp Amos 4:5 (leavener-baking soda or baking powder)
 3 tbs Judges 4:19 (milk)

Directions

Preheat oven to 3:25 degrees.
 Cream together the first three ingredients.
 Beat in 3 eggs until light, one at a time.
 Add the next three ingredients and continue to beat.
 Sift together flour, spices, salt and baking soda or baking powder.
 Add two mixtures together and blend well.
 Blend in milk.
 Spray pan with spray oil. Pour into bundt pan or pour into well greased loaf pan.
 Bake approx. 1 hour or until done.
 Brush with wine (opt)

Slow cooker Macaroni and Cheese

1 (16 oz.) box macaroni
 1 large box Velveeta cheese
 1 stick butter or margarine
 1 can evaporated milk
 Salt and pepper to taste
 Cook macaroni and partially drain, leaving about 1 cup of water in macaroni. Add to slow cooker. Break up cheese and add. Add butter and milk. Salt and pepper to taste. Cook on low heat. Keep checking it and add more milk or water as needed. Stir often and turn to warm after all the cheese is melted.
